Notes Regarding Grade 12 Course Requests

1. The **due date** for course request forms and next year's tuition deposits is **Monday, March 20, 2023**.
2. To complete the registration for the upcoming academic year, **Saskatchewan** students must return this form to the general office with a **\$1000 tuition deposit** payment. **Non-Saskatchewan** students must return this form to the general office with **full payment** of tuition and dorm fees.
3. For answers to academic questions regarding both our regular and International Baccalaureate (IB) programs, students should attend the **information sessions** with the **Academic Vice Principal** scheduled during English classes.
4. **Choir 30** is a full-year program in which students receive **two** credits: Choral 30 and Music 30. Students who choose to take Choir 30 for only one semester will **not** receive any credits; however, students who complete the full-year program will earn **two** credits.
5. **Band** is a regularly scheduled class in semester two; however, to earn this credit, students will augment this class rehearsal time with musical pit orchestra, individual performance opportunities, and Candlelight orchestra.
6. **International Baccalaureate (IB)**: Capable, motivated students interested in an international perspective are able to apply in the spring of their Grade 10 year for the **IB Diploma program**, which is a **two-year** program that begins in the fall of Grade 11. Students requesting individual **IB Certificate courses** are encouraged to take at least three IB courses. Luther offers English, History, and Biology at the **Higher Level**. If students successfully complete these Higher Level classes, they may receive university credit. Mathematics, Chemistry, Environmental Systems and Society, French, German, Drama, Film, Music, and Visual Art are offered at the **Standard Level**. Please contact the **IB Coordinator** or www.ibo.org for further information. Students who request an IB course should not also request the corresponding regular class. For example, students who request IB History 20 should not also request History 20.
7. All **course descriptions** can be found on the Luther College High School website under **Academics > Curriculum**.
8. For information regarding entrance requirements for university, college, or other post-secondary programs, students may consult the **Academic Counsellor**. Luther encourages all students in grade twelve to ensure that they are taking the required classes for their future educational pursuits.
9. **Graduation Requirements**: To be eligible for a Luther diploma, students must obtain a minimum of **26 credits**, five of which must be earned at the 30-level. Students require a minimum of 10 credits in **grade ten**, a minimum of 8 credits in **grade eleven**, and a minimum of 8 credits in **grade twelve**. The **compulsory** courses in grade ten are: ELA A10 and ELA B10, History 10, Ethics 10, Math 10, Science 10, and Wellness 10. The **compulsory** courses in grade eleven are: ELA 20, English Literature & Composition 20, History 20, Christian Ethics 20, Math 20, and Science 20. The **compulsory** courses in grade twelve are: ELA A30 and ELA B30, History 30, Christian Ethics 30, Math 30, and Science 30.
