STUDENT PROTOCOL

WEAR YOUR MASK

Wear your mask in all spaces.

Masks will be worn in the classroom (unless the teacher says otherwise.)

LOCKERS

Go directly to your locker and then your period 2 class. Do not use lockers in the breaks between classes. Carry your backpack from class to class.

ENTERING AND EXITING

Use the west (Semple) entrance.

You'll be given a mask (if you don't have one).

Use hand sanitizer.

You can voluntarily do a hands-free temperature check.

HALĽWAYS

Follow the direction flow.

Do not socialize or sit in hallways.

CLASSROOM

RULES

Sit in your assigned seat.

Use only one device: phone or computer but not both.

At end of the class, wipe down your desk and chair.

Exit the room single file and avoid crowding at the front of the room. If you're in the classroom online, your video must be on to be marked in attendance. Regular dress code applies whether in-person or online.

SPARES

Use available spaces such as the library, cafeteria, Belsher Centre, and open classrooms.

> The Student Commons WILL NOT be available for socializing.

LUNCH

Follow the seating plans in the cafeteria and Belsher Centre.



CHAPEL

You will stay in your period 3 class to attend Chapel. If you have a period 3 spare, go to the Library to attend Chapel.

(The school year will start with Chapel in TAG groups.)

BATHROOMS

Avoid socializing.

Avoid bathrooms if physical distancing cannot be maintained.

KNOW THE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19:

fever, cough, headache, muscle aches, sore throat, chills, runny nose, nasal congestion, conjunctivitis/pink eye, dizziness, fatigue, nausea, diarrhea, loss of appetite/smell/taste, shortness of breath or trouble breathing

IF YOU'RE AT HOME AND FEEL ONE OR MORE SYMPTOMS:

stay home, notify the office, consult your doctor.

IF YOU'RE AT SCHOOL AND FEEL ONE OR MORE SYMPTOMS:

notify the office and then go home immediately or to the isolation space in the Blue Room.

IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE SCHOOL.
