## Duration of Naming Privileges

At this time there are generally three different duration periods (or terms) connected with naming privileges, depending on the gift amount:

Amount of gift	Term of naming privilege
\$25,000 - \$999,999	Up to 10 years
\$1,000,000 – 4,999,999	Up to 20 years
\$5,000,000 +	Up to 30 years

## Details on Donor Recognition

Naming privileges are reserved on a first come, first served basis.

Your gift to *A Time to Build* will be publicly acknowledged in accordance with our donor recognition plan unless you request anonymity. The naming opportunities presented in this booklet are supplemental to Luther's usual donor recognition activities. Upon receipt of your pledge or gift with a naming opportunity request, Luther will provide a written donor recognition memorandum to capture the recognition and naming details. Both parties will sign the memorandum when its contents are mutually approved.
