

Financial Handbook - 2019/2020

All fees are in Canadian dollars.

Application Fee and Deposits

All New Students:

A \$100 non-refundable fee is due with the application.

New and returning Saskatchewan students:

All new Saskatchewan students are required to pay 10% tuition deposit (\$804 for 2019/20) upon acceptance; all returning students must submit a course request form and the deposit by March 22, 2019. This deposit will be applied to the tuition fees. If a student withdraws after May 1, the tuition deposit is forfeit.

Saskatchewan residency is defined in accordance with the regulation of the Ministry of Education of the Government of Saskatchewan. The Government subsidizes the tuition for Saskatchewan students.

New Non-Saskatchewan students:

Full tuition, a \$3,000 education bond, \$500 damage deposit, dorm and ESL fees (if applicable) are due upon acceptance in order to secure a spot in the education program. The education bond is a one-time fee and is refunded upon graduation, less any amounts owing on the student's account.

Returning students must submit their course request form and are required to pay the full Tuition, Dorm, and ESL fees by March 22, 2019. Classes will not be scheduled and a place will not held without full payment of fees.

Damage Deposit

A room damage deposit of \$500 is due upon acceptance. The deposit is refunded when a student withdraws or graduates, less any costs incurred in repairing damage to the room or its fixtures, or any dorm-related charges. The damage deposit is a one-time fee and will be held over the length of the student's stay at Luther College.

Refund of damage deposit and education bond may take up to 8 weeks.

Cafeteria

Day students may purchase a semester lunch plan, purchase meals on a daily basis or load a cash balance on their fob. A semester lunch plan is \$625 per semester. Any cash amount may be loaded on a student's fob; however, there is a 10% savings if you add \$100 or more, i.e. \$110 worth of meals for \$100.

To purchase a single meal the prices are: \$6.25 for breakfast, \$9.00 for lunch and \$10.00 for dinner.

Transportation

Additional Fees

Additional charges apply to activities that students choose to participate in each year or where purchases are made or services rendered specifically for an individual student. Additional fees associated with programs, co-curricular activities and trips other than those listed here may apply and costs vary. Incidental expenses are billed monthly and payment is due within 30 days of billing.

Scholarships, Bursaries and Financial Assistance

Luther College offers a range of financial support options, including scholarships, bursaries and financial assistance for Saskatchewan students. Applications are due March 1. Some scholarships and bursaries are for academic merit; others are for financial need; still others address the interests of students.

Students requesting financial assistance are required to complete the Apple Financial Services online application each year. Applications are accepted starting November 1 and are due by March 1.

Refunds and Withdrawals

Withdrawal notices for out-of-country students must be received in writing by June 14 (November 15 second semester) in order to be eligible for full refunds. All refunds are subject to a 10% tuition administrative charge. If a withdrawal notice is received after the specified date listed all fees will be forfeit.

If a Saskatchewan student withdraws within 60 calendar days of the first day of classes of a semester, tuition fees will be refunded on a prorated basis, (with a minimum of 10% being held). If the student withdraws after this time all fees will be forfeit.

Once a semester has begun there will be no refunds issued for the class fees of ESL, physical education, Communication Media, or IB.

Please note: Refunds may take up to 8 weeks to be processed.

Additional Information

Late Arrivals

Non-Saskatchewan students who arrive or return for classes late will be charged a late fee of \$1500 (taken from their Education Bond).

Payment Methods and Banking Arrangements

All students must submit their payment with their <u>Tuition Payment Form.</u>

International (Non-Saskatchewan) Students

The following forms of payment are accepted:

- Wire transfer or credit card with CIBC Student Pay (preferred method) https://pay.cibc.com/luther
- International money order or certified cheque

Saskatchewan Students

The following forms of payment are accepted:

- Preauthorized debit payment (preferred method) enclose a VOID cheque
- Cash or debit (in person only)
- Cheque, made payable to Luther College, Regina
- Visa or MasterCard

All payments for Saskatchewan and non-Saskatchewan students must be made in Canadian funds. Students are responsible for all bank fees, including charges for wire transfers and payments through Open Apply, Luther College's online application process.

Luther College will not advance or hold funds on behalf of a student.

Penalty for Late Payment

All accounts overdue by 15 days or more may be charged a late payment fee of prime plus 3% interest.

Declined Transaction Fees

All returned cheques, and/or declined pre-authorization payments for tuition payment plans will be charged a \$25 declined transaction fee.

Outstanding Fees

Luther College reserves the right to withhold a student's final marks if fees are outstanding at the end of the academic year.
