

Dear Luther Residents,

As the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve, we have some important updates for you regarding the Luther Cafeteria and the building to help us all protect one another:

1) Change of Access

Starting today (March 23) at 7:00 p.m., all doors of the College will be closed and locked until further notice. This means that you will be required to use your room fob to open the door in the residence foyer to gain access to the hallway that takes you to the cafeteria. Just a friendly reminder that you should ONLY go to the cafeteria, get your meal, and then head back to your room. If you have any issues with the door, please contact your Quad RA, RA on Duty (306-537-6730) or the Luther Residence Office (306-585-5333) during office hours.

2) Change of Food Services and Hours

In compliance with the Saskatchewan Health Authority Public Health Order, the Luther Cafeteria seating area will be closed effective today (March 23), and will be open for take-out meals only. The cafeteria will be open for take-out meals only from 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. daily. We will give you a minimum 24-hour notice in the event that these hours change. Please be assured that there is a steady food supply for the cafeteria, and there will be no food shortages.

3) Social/Physical Distancing Reminder

Our focus continues to be on the health and safety of our entire Luther campus community including you. This, however, requires that we all make a conscious effort to work together to limit exposure and transmission of the virus by elevating our personal hygiene habits, and practising social/physical distancing including the following:

- Maintaining a 2 meter distance between you and the person in front of you while you are waiting in line to get food from the cafeteria.
- Taking your food back with you to your room instead of eating in your quad lounge.
- If you are to socialize in the quad lounges, you must maintain a 2 meter distance between you and other residents.

4) Cleaning of the Residence

With an increase of garbage due to the food containers from the cafeteria, large open-top garbage bins will be placed in each quad, and will be emptied daily by staff. Staff will also continue to clean the residence daily using maximum-strength peroxide cleaners and increase the frequency of cleaning high contact surfaces (e.g. light switches, door handles, taps, etc.) throughout the day.

5. Need Someone to Talk to?
