- Launched in **2010** by Universitas Indonesia
- **Online survey** regarding current condition and policies related to Green Campus and Sustainability in the Universities all over the world
- **Main areas:** Global climate change, energy and water conservation, waste recycling, and green transportation
- Criteria include **baseline information** as the size of the university, both spatially and in terms of population, the campus location and the amount of green space; and also information on energy use, transport, water use and recycling and waste treatment

## Variables





- Energy and Climate Change (EC) (21%)**
