### **Volunteering.**




- CdC volunteering started in 2014.

### How much garbage is produced in Peru?

- → In Peru, more than seven and a half million tons of solid waste are generated each year, of which 64% comes from households, according to data from the Ministry of the Environment.
- → Every day on average, more than 18,000 tons of waste are generated in Peru, of which only 15% is recycled.
- → In Lima, the largest city in the country where almost 10 million people live, about 8,468 tons of garbage are generated daily, which corresponds to 47% of the total produced. Of which, only 4% is recycled.
