#### Mission:

Luther College prepares students to be compassionate, creative, and critical thinkers, through academic excellence and a community of care that is rooted in our call to love and serve our neighbours.

#### Vision:

Luther College makes transformative change for a more grace-filled, just, and joyful world.

These statements were developed after months of stakeholder input and consultation as part of Luther College's strategic planning process.

"It was incredibly important to both our campuses that we took the time to reexamine what Luther College is all about --- what it means to be a Luther student or a Luther employee. The new mission and vision clearly articulate our purpose so that Luther College remains strong and relevant to future generations of students and families," President Rev. Dr. Marc Jerry explains. "It was time, especially after the pandemic, to set an intentional course for the future, and we needed a new vision and mission to help us do that."

Luther College has also developed a set of values which will inform and inspire all that we do.
