The Early Bird payment discount is applicable to Saskatchewan students who are not receiving any other type of bursary/special rates.

Family Discount: Families in Saskatchewan may be eligible to receive a family discount if two or more siblings are enrolled in the same academic year. The discount is equal to 10% of the tuition amount paid per child after bursaries and scholarships have been applied.

Payment Plans TUITION FEES

Luther College offers payment plan options for tuition and/or dorm fees. Payment plans are not available for bus, cafeteria, EAL, IB, extra curricular, and other school fees.

To select a payment plan, you MUST contact Luther's Finance Office at financemanager@luthercollege.edu or 306-585-5333. Recurring payments will be set up through your MySchoolApp student account.

DORM FEES

Dorm fees cover the cost of a double occupancy furnished room, the use of the student lounge, meals, snacks, laundry, high-speed internet, network printer access, and some residence social activities.

ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE (EAL) FEES

EAL fees for both semesters are due upon verification of the student's level. First semester EAL fees are non-refundable. Second semester EAL fees may be partially or fully refunded if the student's EAL level of instruction changes or is no longer required.

- Foundations \$5,000 per semester
- Advanced \$4,000 per semester
- Higher Level \$3,000 per semester

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) FEES

Non-refundable. Payable once course requests and schedules are finalized.

- Grade 11 diploma students \$395 per year
- Grade 12 diploma students \$480 per year
- Grade 11 course students \$285 per year
- Grade 12 course students \$395 per year

DEPOSIT FEE

- A \$1,000 tuition deposit fee is required to secure your student's space.
- The deposit fee will be applied to tuition fees.
- New Students: deposit fee due upon acceptance.
- Returning Students: deposit fee for all current Grade 9-11 students will be accepted beginning March 1, 2026 and are due March 25, 2026.
- Deposit fee is refundable until 4:30 p.m. on April 30, 2026.

OTHER FEES

Non-refundable.

- Communication Media \$150 per class (payable once course schedules are finalized).
- Physical Education (Grade 11 & 12) \$150 per class (payable once course schedules are finalized).
- Admission Application Fee \$100 (due at application).
- Apple Financial Assessment Fee \$137.50 (50% of the Assessment Fee will be subsidized after the account is created at applefinancialservices.ca).

Additional charges apply to activities that students choose to participate in each year or where purchases are made, or services rendered specifically for an individual student. Additional fees associated with programs, co-curricular activities, and trips other than those listed here may apply and costs vary. Incidental expenses may be billed monthly, and payment is due within 30 days of billing.

SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES

Deadline to apply is March 1, 2026

Entrance scholarships are for new Grade 9 students with academic potential, community involvement, good character, and other criteria. Bursaries are for students with demonstrated financial need who exhibit academic potential and any other criteria as outlined in the terms of the bursary. Families who apply for bursaries must also complete a financial needs assessment through Apple Financial Services. This is not a loan program.
