

Honour Roll Criteria

80%

THE THRESHOLD

Honour roll is calculated on a **six-mark average** using the student's best mark in each of the six course categories below. Honour roll is awarded when that average is over 80%.

THE SIX CATEGORIES

- 1 Christian Ethics
- 2 English
- 3 Fine Arts, Language Acquisition, and Physical Education
- 4 History
- 5 Mathematics
- 6 Science

If two or more marks meet a single requirement, the highest mark is used.

OTHER CRITERIA

- Courses counted are those at the grade level the student is registered in for that academic year (Grade 11 students, for example, use only 20-level courses).
- Only classes taken at Luther College count toward honour roll consideration. Online courses and courses taken at other schools are not considered. Students may take up to one course off campus each year, but all mandatory courses must be taken at Luther.
- Students must be in good standing, as determined by the administration.
- Students must pass all their courses in the current school year.
- When a single class runs across two semesters, the two semester marks count as two separate marks.

Exceptional circumstances. The vice-principal of academics may waive some honour roll requirements for students whose circumstances prevented them from meeting one or more of them. Questions may be directed to the main office.
