

Full tuition fees (which include a one time education bond of \$3,000) and full dorm fees (which include a damage deposit of \$500) are due upon acceptance. Families who cannot pay in full upon acceptance must contact the Luther College Finance Office to set up a payment plan.

Acceptance documents will be provided upon full payment or when the first payment of \$10,000 is received.

Payments may be made by credit card or wire transfer. For assistance with either payment method, please contact our Finance Office at financemanager@luthercollege.edu or 306-585-5333.

International students are required to live in the on-campus dormitory.

Dorm fees cover the cost of a double occupancy furnished room, the use of the student lounge, meals, snacks, laundry, high-speed internet, network printer access, and some residence social activities.

Dorms are closed during the Christmas break. Dorm students are welcome to stay in our dorms over the Easter break for an additional daily fee.

Luther College offers payment plan options for tuition and dorm fees. Payment plans are not available for EAL, IB, extra curricular, and other school fees.

* Tuition fees include a \$3,000 education bond. This is a one-time fee which is refunded upon graduation from Luther College High School, minus any amounts owing on the student's account.

** Dorm fees include a \$500 damage deposit, which is collected yearly and refunded upon move-out from Luther College High School dorms, minus any amounts owing for damages.

ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE (EAL) FEES

EAL fees for both semesters are due upon verification of the student's level. First semester EAL fees are non-refundable. Second semester EAL fees may be partially or fully refunded if the student's EAL level of instruction changes or is no longer required.

- Foundations..... \$5,000 per semester
- Advanced..... \$4,000 per semester
- Higher Level..... \$3,000 per semester

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) FEES

Non-refundable. Payable once course requests and schedules are finalized.

- Grade 11 diploma students \$395 per year
- Grade 12 diploma students \$480 per year
- Grade 11 course students..... \$285 per year
- Grade 12 course students..... \$395 per year

OTHER FEES

Non-refundable.

- Communication Media \$150 per class (payable once course schedules are finalized).
- Physical Education (Grade 11 & 12)..... \$150 per class (payable once course schedules are finalized).
- Admission Application Fee \$100 (due at application).

Additional charges apply to activities that students choose to participate in each year or where purchases are made, or services rendered specifically for an individual student. Additional fees associated with programs, co-curricular activities, and trips other than those listed here may apply and costs vary. Incidental expenses may be billed monthly, and payment is due within 30 days of billing.

SCHOLARSHIPS

NEW international dorm students who are accepted by June 1, 2026 may be eligible to receive a scholarship up to \$10,750 towards tuition.

STUDY PERMIT REFUSAL REFUND POLICY

In the event that a student's study permit application is refused by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), the school will provide a refund of tuition fees paid, less any non-refundable fees (if applicable), provided that, an official copy of the study permit refusal letter issued by IRCC is submitted to the school. Refunds will only be processed upon verification of the refusal documentation. **Please note that any application fees, registration fees, or other designated non-refundable deposits may be retained by the school.**
